NOVENA TO OUR LADY OF LOURDES AND THE WOLD DAY OF THE SICK

The Novena to Our Lady of Lourdes began on Wed. 3 Feb. and continues until Thur. 11 Feb., the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. The Novena Prayer will be said at all Masses. In this year of pandemic we pray in a special way for all those suffering from Covid-19 and all medical staff.

The World Day of the Sick takes place on Thur. 11 Feb., The Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. Pope Francis states that the World Day of the Sick provides an "opportunity to devote special attention to the sick and to those who provide them with assistance and care both in healthcare institutions and within families and communities". The Pope reminds us that, as Christians, we should always practice what we preach and reach out in a tangible way to those who are sick and suffering, particularly the marginalised and the poor. Pope Francis entrusts the sick, healthcare workers, and all those who assist the suffering to the care of Our Lady.
